

PAINTCO SAKHER 1511

DESCRIPTION

Paintco SAKHER is water borne texture finish based on pure acrylic and U.V resistant natural color aggregates, giving archetype beauty to the exterior walls.
A commendable feature of this product is, excellent durability , resists alkali, atmospheric pollutants and harsh climatic condition of Middle East.. it is APEO, formaldehyde and ammonia free. Longevity of this coating enhanced by over coating of Paintco Acrylic Matt Clear.

APPLICATION DATA :

Application method:	hopper gun and smooth plastic roller
Type of Thinner:	Sweet Water
Nozzle size :	2.5-3.0 mm

Theor. coverage:	0.25- 0.30 square meter/ Kg. (depending on surface condition and thickness of the coat)

SURFACE PREPARATION :

New surface must be cured at least 28 days prior to application . All surfaces must be thoroughly prepared ,clean and should be free of alkali and efflorescence, for repair and maintenance, remove damaged and loose paint by mechanical cleaning and dust off. Recommend to be used over Paintco latex primer sealer.

PAINTING SYSTEM :

Paint should be stirred properly before use. Apply one coat of paintco latex primer sealer and leave it for full dry. Apply paintco sakher with hopper gun in proper and even thickness . Press with smooth plastic roller, when the product is dry to touch. Then let it fully dry. Apply one coat of Paintco Acrylic Clear matt after hard dry.

REMARKS :

Paintco Sakher is Ideal for exterior application. It is also suitable for application over primed concrete, cement and brick surface.
